Accessing sector results

In order to use the sector view, you must first be approved as a sector body user.

When you register on the <u>Employer Standards portal</u>, you will need to indicate that you are from a sector body . The CEC team will then approve your access.

Consider which sectors reflect your work, the sectors you choose here will be reflected in the dashboard.




Sector results view (cont...)
